Warm Start - No update.

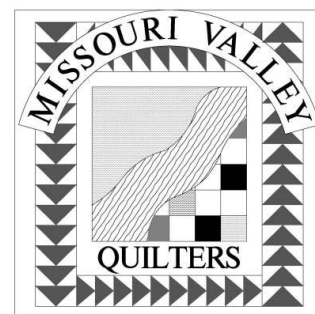
Christmas Party - Party was a huge success. Thanks to the committee!
