Eight layettes were delivered to St. Alexius in November. The committee can always use quilts.


MVQ is going "green" for this year's Christmas party, by reusing and recycling what we have!

22nd Annual 'Frozen Fabric Frolic' Quilt Retreat

Missouri Valley Quilters, Bismarck-Mandan Will be held at Camp of the Cross, Garrison ND February 18-20, 2022 Quilt Retreat will begin Friday afternoon and will end 4:00 PM Sunday All sewing and meals will be in the Fellowship Center \$175 Registration Fee. \$75 is required with application. Cancellation before Feb. 13, 2022 will receive a refund minus a \$10 fee.

Meals provided are: Supper Friday, Brunch & Supper Saturday, Brunch Sunday

Lodging Choices:

- 1. Dormitory style cabin included with the registration fee. Each of the cabins has its own bathrooms, but shower facilities are located in another building. You will need to bring your own bedding, pillows, towels, etc.
- 2. Semi-private cabin, additional \$20 fee. Shared with another person, bathroom and shower are connected and will be shared with another cabin. Please provide names if you would like to share or a roommate will be assigned as needed. Bedding and towels are provided.
- 3. **Retreat Lodge, additional \$35 fee.** Private rooms, also has 3 bedrooms large enough to share. Please provide names if you plan to share rooms. Bedding and towels are provided in the Retreat Lodge.

We will do our best to accommodate your lodging request but cannot guarantee your first choice. The Retreat Lodge and Semi-private cabins will be filled "First come-first served" based on your application postmark.

Applications will be accepted based on postmark, but will not be accepted early. Members of Missouri Valley Quilters may send in their registration on December 1, 2021 Open registration will begin January 1, 2022 for non-members of MVQ.
