Missouri Valley Quilt Guild General Meeting Minutes September 16, 2021

President Teresa Chase called the meeting to order. The September meeting is our annual membership drive. Dues are \$20. 2 new members joined- Janice and Jana.

August Meeting Minutes- no additions or corrections.

Treasurer's report - \$7151.73 This amount does include the DWAC grant for the National Teacher.

Old Business:

National Teacher committee – The classes will take place Nov. 5-6, with a trunk show on Sunday, November 7. Classes are being limited to 25 students/ day. The classes are filling quickly with only a few spots open for each class. Once the classes are filled, a waitlist will be started in case anyone cancels. Volunteers will be needed for various duties, including clean up.

Warm Start – Barb indicated they are in need of quilts. She did receive a number of quilts at the meeting, including a number that were donated by the family of Ethyl Tischmack.

Christmas Party – The Christmas Party will take place on Dec. 2. The theme is Reuse, Recycle, Redo. There will be a challenge to make Christmas stockings, which will be donated to 2 nursing homes. This will be a non-judged challenge. Patterns for the stocking are available along with fabric. For the first stocking turned in, you will receive a gift. If you donate additional stockings, you will be entered for a drawing.

Frozen Fabric Frolic- will take place Feb 18-20 at Camp of the Cross. One class will be offered. The registration form will be in the November newsletter.

Girls Night In will take place on October 15 (6:30-11) and October 16 (8-4). The church will be contacted to see if we will be able to bring food in for this event.

November meeting topic will be tips, tools and techniques. Northwinds Stitcher expo will be Sept. 17-18. There will be virtual classes and a shop hop. Capital Quilters are celebrating their 40th anniversary at the Heritage Center on September 25, from 1:30 to 3:30 pm.

Election of officers - 2 Positions are open - Vice President/ President Elect and Secretary. These are both 2 year positions. We do not have any volunteers for either position. Sandi Washek is elected president. She would like members to please think about volunteering for the open position.

New Business:

New Member package – We will be starting this up again. The package will include bylaws, pattern for name tag and information about Designer Genes and Warm Start. Work will also be done on the informational brochure.

Michele Ripplinger created an outline of a new budget, copies were distributed to members. A motion was made to approve the budget by Marlene Sapa, seconded by Penny Wolf.
