Old Business:

Election of officers was discussed and the positions that need to be filled: Vice President, Treasurer, and Newsletter Editor. The election process was reviewed. Maxine will take over once elected. The signature for the check book will need to be changed after the elections.

The guild needs to talk to Velma at the House of Prayer Church to provide them with the 2023 MVQ meeting dates, in writing. The church needs to be informed by November.

Programs that are set for the next 3 months:
